Midgard is located 85 km (90 min.) north-east of Windhoek and only 70 km from Hosea Kutako International Airport in the unspoiled Otjihavera Mountains. An ultimate location for a "weekend away" with the family, a perfect first or last stop for international visitors starting or ending their journey through Namibia and the ideal venue for meetings, conferences and events or weddings.

Carl List, the founder of the Namibian Corporation Ohlthaver & List, acquired Midgard in 1937. His son, Carl Werner List, farmed the 12 000 hectare estate, growing this private and intimate world into a household name in Namibia. Today our guests are invited to enjoy the tranquility, while marvelling at the pioneering German Settler

spirit which gave birth to it all. "Midgard", a word found in Old Norse, Middle English and High German languages, has varying meanings, but is popularly thought to mean "A paradise where the earth rises again, fertile and green, creating a protected world and a safe empire for the people".

Midgard offers 90 fully equipped rooms, The Barn restaurant, two swimming pools, a gym and spa as well as Namibia's one and only private skittle alley (Sven's Kegelbahn). The lodge is spaciously situated in a sprawling country garden, bordering the banks of the Swakop River, as it meanders through the lodge on its way to the Atlantic Ocean.

Our game park is home to giraffes, blue and black wildebeests, oryx, kudus, hartebeests, eland, smaller antelope species, warthogs and baboons. With a good portion of luck, even brown hyena and leopards can be spotted.



TIME ZONE




Lawns with undercover spectator areas are available for weddings, teambuilding and sporting activities.

LODGE DIRECTION & ACCESS

ACCESS BY ROAD

Midgard is situated 85 km (±90 minutes) northeast from Windhoek, and about 70 km from the Hosea Kutako International Airport.

From Windhoek on the B6 towards the International Airport: Take the M53 turn off at Kapps Farm (±20 km). Continue along the gravel road until the road intersects with the D2102, where you will turn left. Travel 55 km along the D2102 until you reach Midgard on your left. Allow ±90 minutes travelling time.

From Windhoek on the B1 towards Okahandja: Turn right onto the D2102 and continue on the gravel road until you reach Midgard on your right $(\pm 59 \text{ km})$. Allow for $\pm 90 \text{ minutes travelling time}$.

From the Hosea Kutako International Airport: Turn right at the Neudamm Agricultural College onto the D2102. After ±7 km continue

straight across the intersection onto the D2102. Travel 55 km along the D2102 until you reach Midgard on your left. Allow for ± 90 minutes traveling time by road.

From Okahandja: On the B1 turn left onto the D2102 and continue on the tarred road for 25km, followed by gravel until you reach Midgard on your right. Allow for ±60 minutes travelling time.
